



iMCards - Quickstart

Flash Cards for iPhone iPod touch iPad





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Main Window

The main window displays a list of all available lessons together with additional information for each lesson.

The list of lessons is divided into two sections. The first one shows the RECENTLY LEARNED LESSONS. The second section shows all the other lessons alphabetically sorted. In brackets you see the amount of lessons. In Settings you can change the amount of lessons displayed in section RECENTLY LEARNED LESSONS.



Group Filter and Settings

The four buttons at the bottom of the list filter the list by groups. The most left button shows all not assigned lessons. The three other one will filter the list according the settings.

The most right button opens the Settings.

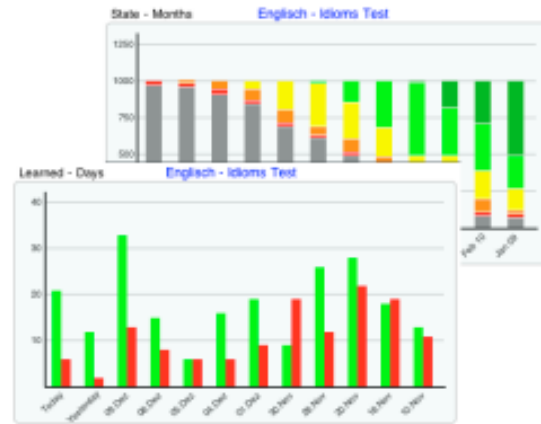


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Manage

Manages the chosen lesson:

- Display statistics (just turn to landscape!)
- Change lesson name
- Add flash cards
- Delete a lesson
- Reset / Refresh a lesson
- Set font size and color
- Choose a certain box to learn from
- Send Backup E-Mail
- Share lesson with other users



Learn only a certain box

The system according to Dr. Leitner will choose the right box for the next learning session. Anyway you are able to choose the box by your own. This setting will be deactivated on program exit.

Refresh

Moves a certain amount of flash cards from box 5 back to box 4. This is done for reviewing words you have already learned.

Backup a lesson via E-Mail



All data of a single lesson or all changed lessons of a group will be sent as E-Mail attachment to any address you want. The backup itself contains two files for each lesson, which you should always keep together.

Restore backup

Is done with free program iMCardsPC, which is unfortunately only available on PC.

1. copy the Backup-files from the E-Mail to the folder *iMCardsPC/Backups*
2. start iMCardsPC and start *Restore iPhone Backup*
3. choose the files and run the restore



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Add new flash cards to lesson



Settings - Dictionary

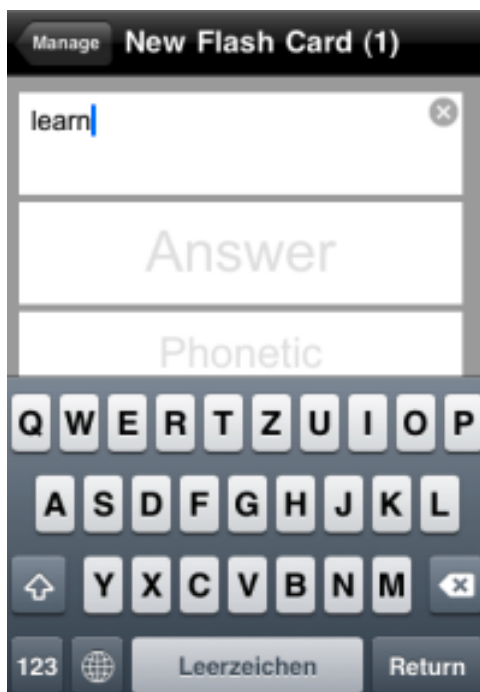
With activated dictionary you just enter the question. The program will fill the answer and when available also the phonetic field as soon as you tip in the answer field.

The next version of iMCards will come with more dictionaries for more languages.

iMCards only look up in the dictionary if the answer field is empty. This works also when you enter the answer and the question field is empty, iMCards will fill the question.

Settings - Show fields

Hide/show the Info and Phonetic fields.



Add flash card

Enter the content. As soon as the question and the answer fields are not empty a *Save* button will appear in the top right corner. With this button you can add the flash card to the lesson. After this the program is ready to enter the content of another flash card.



Landscape mode is also supported.



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Learn



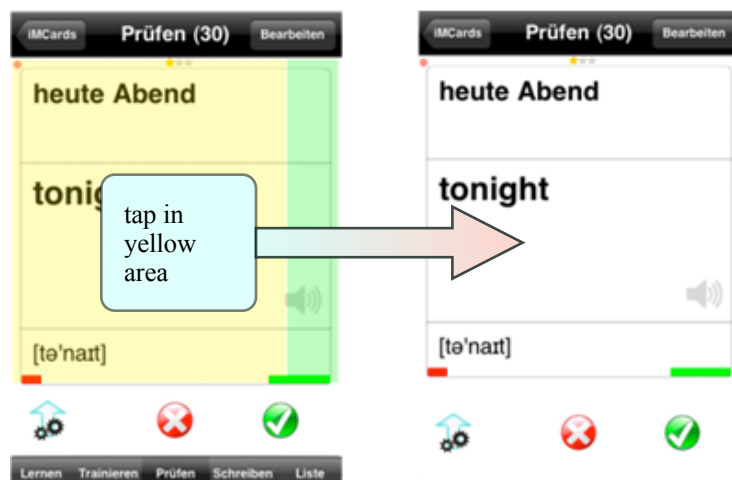
Switch between the different learn-dialogs with the buttons at the bottom. With each switch to another learn-dialog the flash cards will be shuffled again.

- The point on the top left shows the color of the box in which the flash card is.
- The stars are a sign how difficult it is for you to learn the flash card. Color and amount of stars are calculated based on the Good/Bad-counters. Please see a detailed description of the learning-system on our homepage - [Link to homepage](#).

Hide Learn-Mode-Buttons

Tap in the yellow area to hide the Learn-Mode buttons. The Navigation-buttons will move down a little bit. In this way it is not possible to hit the learn-mode buttons accidentally. Tap again into the yellow area to show the Learn-Mode buttons.

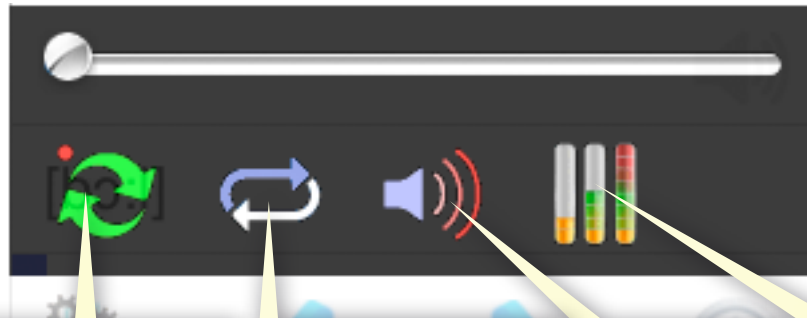
In the green area you are able to scroll the texts and use common Copy&Paste functionality.





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Description of Options-Buttons



Swap question/answer

Red point on top: Question / Answer
Red point at bottom: Answer / Question
Blue points at top and bottom: Question and answer will change automatically every time the learn dialoges are opened.

Loop On/Off

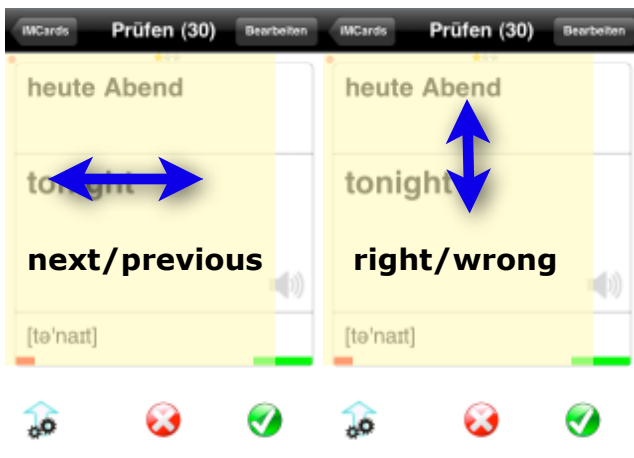
After the last flash card continue with first on of same session

Audio response On/Off

Display/hide volume slider

Accelerator and Gesture

Both are available for navigation in Learn-Dialogs. Activate them in the iPhone-Settings for iMCards.



The yellow marked area is sensitive for gestures. There are gestures for next/previous flash card and answer is right/wrong.

In the green area you are able to scroll the texts and use common Copy&Paste functionality.
